Dr. Aiwen Wu is an Attending in the Gastrointestinal Cancer Center, Peking University Cancer Hospital (PKCH). He graduated from Shandong Medical University and received his M.D. from Peking University. In 2008 he received his Ph.D. degree of management in Renmin University of China. He completed his residency in general surgery at Peking University First Hospital and his fellowship in surgical oncology at PKCH. He got the Mammadi Soudavar Fellowship and visited the Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center in 2009 and then to National Cancer Center Japan in 2010. He was now the chief of Gastrointestinal Cancer Center Unit III and also the chief of Business Office of PKCH.

Dr. Wu specializes in the treatment of patients with gastric cancer and colorectal cancer. Dr. Wu's main research interests are comprehensive management of GI malignancies, especially the adenocarcinoma of the gastroesophageal junction, and sphincter-saving strategies and middle to low rectal cancer. He is quite expertise in open and minimally invasive surgery of GI malignances. In the field of hospital management, he is specialized in performance management.

He is now active in the field of gastric cancer and colorectal cancer and the vice president of Youth Committee of CGCA. He has succeeded in holding the CGCC annual meeting since 2009 as the secretary general and also the IGCC 2017.
